1.B.3.A. Extended Weather Outlook: Temperatures continue in the upper 70s to mid 80s across Missouri, along with low humidity. Both temperature and humidity are expected to start rising this weekend, but conditions should remain dry. The next chance of rain and thunderstorms is early next week. Flood gauge forecasts do not currently predict any moderate or major flooding from this event. No MONG involvement anticipated at this time.


